Pryde Schropp McComb Inc. (PSMI) in association with Gulf Engineering Consultancy of Muscat, Oman are leading a team of airport engineers, architects, planners and specialty consultants for the development of a new international airport in Ras Al Hadd, Oman. The airport will serve domestic and international traffic and provide an air transport link to the coastal region where tourism development is underway and will be enhanced in the coming years. The area is also host to the unique and protected Green Turtles.

The project will include the provision of a fully ICAO compliant airfield including a single 4000m runway and associated visual and electronic navigational aids to support CAT II precision approaches. The 20,000 sq. m Passenger Terminal Building will accommodate up to two gated aircraft ranging from regional jets to the B747. The project design, construction and commissioning period spans 2006 through 2012.
