TAXIWAY ALPHA REHABILITATION



Pryde Schropp McComb, Inc. (PSMI) was retained by the Grande Prairie Airport Commission to oversee the Taxiway Alpha Rehabilitation in 2007.

The project was funded in part by Transport Canada's Airport Capital Assistance Program (ACAP) and involved the full reconstruction of a 1.25km taxiway including the rehabilitation of an adjacent 'deadzone' pavement used for hangar access. PSMI was responsible for the project management including the planning, design, tendering, contract administration, construction supervision, inspection and quality assurance.

Construction was completed through a series of coordinated stages that minimized the operational impact to airport operators/stakeholders. PSMI worked closely with management of the Grande Prairie Airport and Nav Canada from the onset to ensure that proper notification of airfield modifications was given to all users of the airport.
