Pryde Schropp McComb, Inc. (PSMI) was retained by the City of Barrie on behalf of the Lake Simcoe Regional Airport Commission to manage the \$14 million Airport Development Program for their Airport. The project is comprised of various expansion and rehabilitation component projects including the Extension of Runway 10-28 to 6,000ft., Expansion of the Air Terminal Building, Airport Security and Wildlife Fencing, Terminal Building Parking Lot Expansion, Airport Maintenance Facility, and extensive Commercial Development including the construction of a new partial parallel taxiway, development of commercial lots and upgrades to the existing sanitary sewer and water distribution systems.

PSMI has a strong relationship with the LSRA having completed the planning, engineering and project management for the Airports initial construction in 1992. As part of our current assignment, PSMI is providing project management services for the proposed development projects scheduled for completion in March 2011.

The work involves actively managing and coordinating all aspects of the development including detailed consultations with the Lake Simcoe Regional Airport Commission, the City of Barrie and various regulatory and approval agencies.
